As many of you may know, there were a few issues with DartConnect (DC) on Wednesday night. While I'm not 100% sure what caused it, it appears there was a communication issue where the tablets and DC servers were not syncing correctly that evening. Some of those matches did sync later in the week.

After working with DartConnect for several seasons, I've seen this type of issue come up a handful of times, and unfortunately it happened again this week. In these cases, I may be notified of a change and make a manual correction, only to have a later sync overwrite that correction, requiring it to be fixed again. I wanted to make everyone aware of this in case you notice something similar. If you do, please let me know so I can take care of it. This is also a good time to remind all Captains and Co-Captains that matches need to be saved at the end of the night. If a match isn't saved, it can remain open and cause problems later. If you ever have questions or notice something that doesn't look right, please don't hesitate to reach out.

Now that the serious stuff is out of the way, let's get into the fun part – the stats and standings. Week 2 is officially in the books, and while we're starting to see some early trends, it's still very early in the season and plenty can change.

The first stat we're going to look at is an '01 stat: HDIT (High Double In Turn – any). This measures the highest double hit on any turn. The REC division does have an advantage with this stat, as they play 301 (Double-In, Double-Out).

The second stat focuses on Cricket games. Most Cricket stats are fairly self-explanatory, and there are quite a few of them, so over the course of the season I'll be highlighting different ones.
